Our mission is to mobilize faith communities, financial partners, and all segments of society towards ending human trafficking and creating new futures through community-based action.

Our Mission 2021 Impact Report

We are accomplishing this mission through three focus areas:



Extending Mercy at the Margins:

By mobilizing their local community, teams serve those who are marginalized, and most at risk of trafficking. They extend unconditional care, counseling services, training sessions, hygiene packets, emotional support, and more to reduce human trafficking vulnerabilities in the communities they call home.



Child and Youth Protection:

Teams across the globe bring hope and healing to children that are vulnerable to being trafficked through awareness, prevention, and intervention methods. They educate, advocate, support, and mentor children to increase their resiliency to human trafficking.



Education, Awareness, and Training:

Through community-based action, teams create locally-informed awareness campaigns and equip societal influencers with the tools and resources they need to educate others. Through dedicated training, equipping, educating, and advocating, communities come together to reduce the vulnerabilities of human trafficking.

Key Milestones

Training and Awareness

We engaged with community partners, businesses, agencies, and organizations, more than **500 times in 2021.**

We are partnering strong with local communities to fight trafficking in ways that make sense in their local contexts.

Fostering Hope & Youth Training:

In 2021 we directly supported and trained more youth than ever before. With a special focus on foster youth, we engaged with more than 1,400+ youth.







12 new leaders: SFM onboarded 12 new leaders representing new and growing local teams across the United States in 2021.

MyPlace, a launched ministry

MyPlace, a launched ministry of SFM, opened its doors in March 2021 and served 9 residents throughout 2021. This March, we will celebrate their one year anniversary.



A Deeper Look 2021 Impact Report



The SFM team in Rochester, NY partners with a restoration home and food bank ministry, they are an essential support system to their community.

Hungary

We are preventing the exploitation of at-risk children and ethnic minorities in Hungary by providing a safe place for youth to find belonging and mentorship. The team is creating a resource, especially for young women, to educate them on how human trafficking happens and what to look out for.



In Indianapolis, IN, the SFM team supports and encourages women at a local women's prison through a mosquito net sewing program. This ministry helps the women to recognize their value despite their current circumstances. These mosquito nets are then distributed to areas of the world where malaria and other mosquitoborne diseases are prevalent.



In Kenya, SFM partner organization THRIVE is educating and protecting young women from the vulnerability of gender based violence and human trafficking.



Leaders in India repatriate missing and trafficked children. They raise crucial awareness regarding human trafficking, equip caregivers and churches to protect their children against child exploitation, and navigate avenues of resource access.


